Arbier	Seaham	Renaissance	4.1	Yellow	Modern golden hoppy beer with a bitter fruity edge
Arcane Bridge	Newcastle	Gurke	4	Light Yellow	Classic pale with a twist. Gurke is German for cucumber.
Arcane Bridge	Newcastle	Bosch	5.2	Black	Classic rich porter with Islay peated malt and enriched with real vanilla pods
Camerons	Hartlepool	Strongarm	4	Red	The caramel aroma and initial sweet taste is followed by a full blooded malty flavour. More treat than trick!
Camerons	Hartlepool	V Twin	4.1	Red	Classic amber British bitter brewed with Cascade hops with a late copper addition of Mosaic to give it a satisfying full flavour
Castle Rock	Nottingham	Black Gold	3.8	Black	A well balanced, dark mild ale with some bitterness, but not overly sweet.
Castle Rock	Nottingham	Sherwood Reserve Coffee Stout	4.5	Black	English stout brewed with fresh coffee beans. Sherwood Reserve is smooth, balanced and decadent, with notes of chocolate and coffee.
Charwood	Loughborough	Salvation	3.8	Yellow	A light refreshing golden beer, with tropical fruit, citrus, and floral flavours. American Cascade and Amarillo hops create a citrus aroma, and crisp clean bitterness on the finish.
Dancing Duck	Derby	Twenty Two	4.3	Orange	A wonderfully balanced best bitter with good malty flavour and dark fruit notes, these are offset by a strong hop with a very clean finish. A great thirst quenching beer for any time of the day.
Darwin	Sunderland	Richmond Ale	4.8	Red	A Traditional northern brown ale
Dow Bridge	Cathorpe Leics	Fosse Ale	4.8	Orange	Well balanced, premium beer with caramel & burnt toffee flavours leading to a hoppy, dry finish.
Elland	W Yorkshire	1872 Porter	6.5	Black	Rich, complex and dark porter from an original 1872 recipe, with an old port nose, and coffee and bitter chocolate flavours on the palate. The ideal beer for chilly Autumn evenings and winter nights. Champion Beer of Great Britain 2013.
Everards	Narborough	Original	5.2	Red	Smooth, full-bodied and fruity, with a delightful delicate hopiness. Although the flavours are complex, no single flavour predominates to upset the ale's exceptional balance. The finish is malty and sweetish, the colour, a copper brown.
Filpside	Colwick	Random Toss	4.4	Yellow	A refreshing pale ale with lemon and lime tropical fruit flavours. Brewed using quality malt giving it a light golden colour. Became an 'occasional brew' as from Spring 14
Grafton	Worksop	Lady Ruby Cherry	5	Red	A ruby coloured ale. Fruity on the nose with an initial bitterness on the palate which leads to a cherry explosion on the back of the tongue.
Grafton	Worksop	Dark Lady Aniseed Beer	4.5	Black	A dark, almost black beer with an underlying rich roast flavour followed by aniseed bursting on the tongue.
Humpty Dumpty	Reedham Norfolk	Lemon & Ginger	4	Yellow	Light coloured ale with a refreshing lemon and ginger flavour.
Leeds	Leeds	Midnight Bell	4.8	Black	A premium dark mild. Roast and chocolate malts combine to give a full bodied, complex character to this rich and robust ale.
Maxim	Houghton	Swedish Blond	4.2	Yellow	Named after Maxim Breweries own Anna Goransdotter - Bell, this smooth blonde beer is very light in colour and uses cascade and first gold hops to give refreshing hoppy and complex grapefruit flavours on the palate.
Maxim	Houghton	Maximum Speed	4.3	Orange	Brewed blending American hops including Chinook to give a spicy piney and grapefruit flavours and aromas
Maxim	Houghton	Maximus	6	Red	A strong and warming beer that is also smooth and easy to drink, dark, ruby in colour. Maximus is described as smooth, sweet, with a hint of liquorice.
Slaters	Eccleshall	Top Totty	4	Yellow	A stunning blonde beer, full bodied with a voluptuous aroma. It has a ripe generous fruitiness with and complex hop notes and a rich maltiness.
Titanic	Burslem	Stout	4.5	Black	Strong and mysterious describes both this beer and the men from below decks. Light in colour and generously hopped, this will stake the thirist of the hardest working person.
Titanic	Burslem	Plum Porter	4.9	Black	This beer is dark, strong and well rounded, the richness of such a rotund beer is brought to an even keel by the late addition of Goldings hops and natural plum flavouring.
Totally Brewed	Nottingham	Captain Hopbeard	5.5	Yellow	Arrrr! This pacific pale ale is saturated with Australian and New Zealand hops to deliver tropical flavours of pineapple and passion fruit with a background of spice and molasses.
Windswept	Lossiemouth	Weizen	5	Yellow	A German Hefeweizen. Cloudy effervescent amber. It has a massive bouquet of dove and bananas. Flavours of caramel, spice, sweet fruit and light citrus.
Yates	Wigton	Bitter	3.7	Orange	A carefully balanced full bodied bitter, golden in colour with complex hoppy bitterness. Good aroma and well respected distinctive flavour.
